On the 22nd of November 1975, two days after the death of Franco, Juan Carlos became king. At the moment he is enjoying popular support from Spanish people, and in 2008 he was voted the most popular leader in all Ibero-American states. At present he is working hard to promote Ibero-American relations. He speaks Spanish, English, French, Italian and Portuguese. He likes sport and while the Spanish football team were celebrating their 2010 World Cup victory, he told them 'You made our best dreams come true.'

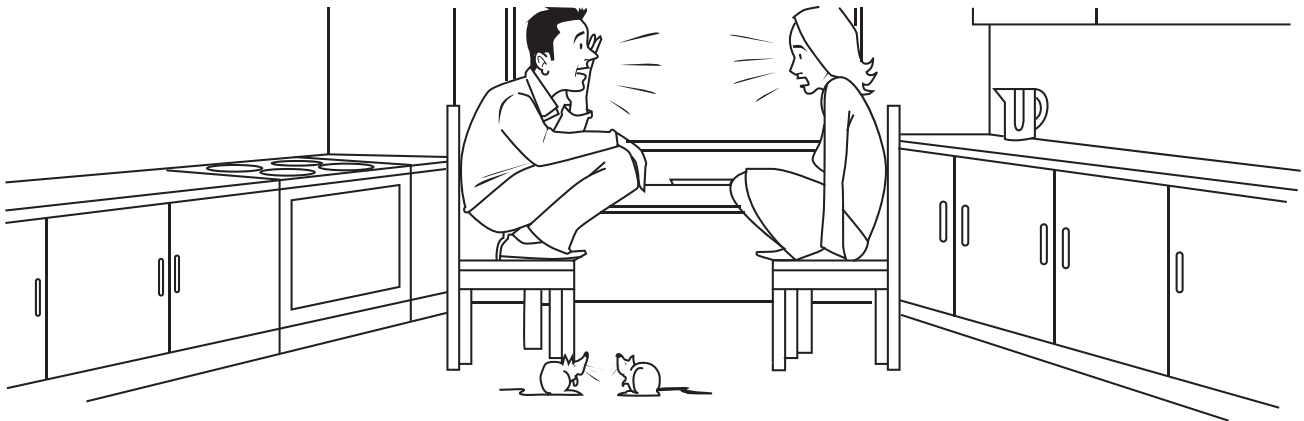
King Juan Carlos I of Spain

In 1977 she celebrated her Silver Jubilee (twenty-five years), and in 2002 she celebrated her Golden Jubilee (fifty years). At the moment, she is hoping to become the longest-reigning queen in British history. (This will actually happen on the 10th of September 2015.) She lives at Buckingham Palace, but it is reported that she prefers Windsor Castle. Currently, she is working hard to promote her 600 charities and organisations.
